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Report

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The 68th session of UNCITRAL Working Group IV (Electronic Commerce) was held from 24 to 28 March 2025 at the United Nations Headquarters in New York. The Working Group is tasked with developing and harmonising international legal standards to facilitate electronic transactions and digital trade. The Moot Alumni Association (MAA) was invited to attend as an observer for the session of the Working Group and designated Nahida Mamache as a representative. This report provides an overview and critical analysis of the discussions and outcomes of the Working Group’s sixty-eighth session.
